

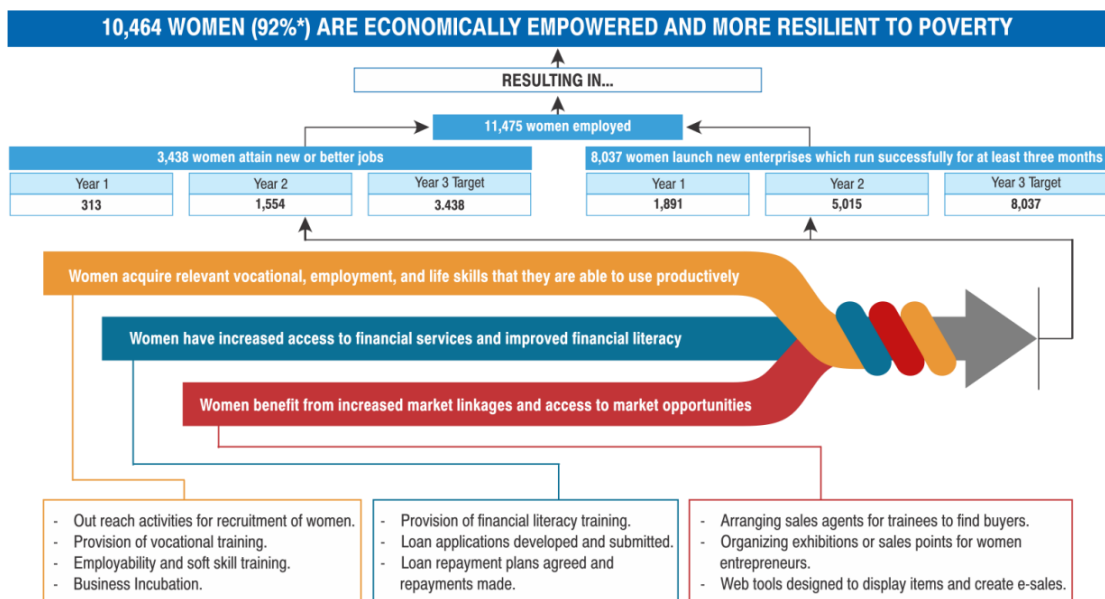
WOMEN ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

This portfolio also covers a Women Economic Empowerment Programme funded by UKAID from July 2017 to June 2020.

The programme aims at **increased** income of **10,464 women** through **engaging** **11,475 women** in income generation activities.

The key investment areas of the programme include capacity building, access to finance, market linkages development, and connecting potential employers.

The programme has been rolled out in 11 districts i.e., Karachi and Khairpur of Sindh Province and Bhawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Lodhran, Vehari, Multan, Lahore, Gujranwala, Kasur, and Dera Ghazi Khan of Punjab by ten direct/sub-grantees' local organizations namely; Aman Foundation, Akuwat Islamic Micro-Finance, Kaarvan Craft Foundation, Injaz Pakistan, Basic Needs Pakistan, Center for Economic Research in Pakistan, LUMS and Charter for Compassion and Memon Industrial and Technical Institute.
